

OREGON COLLEGE LOAN CODE OF CONDUCT *

— EFFECTIVE as of April 30, 2008 —

I. Definitions

A. "College" shall mean any postsecondary education institution in Oregon.

B. "College employees" shall mean any College officer, administrator, or employee.

C. "Education loan lending institution" shall mean any entity other than a college or university which is in the business of making loans to students, parents or others for
